The 4th round of the Austrian Nationals and the 1st run ever on astro turf was held at ERT-Steyregg on 9th and 10th of September 2017.

The weather predictions were not the best, so we decided to drive 3 qualification runs on Saturday. The track at ERT-Steyregg is an astro turf course, which has fast and also technical passages.

On Saturday after 3 runs with my 4WD PR SW401 LW powered by Hobbywing, I could qualify in A-main as 7th. With my 2WD Team Associated B6, also powered by Hobbywing, it was possible for me to also qualify in A-main as 3rd.

The weather remained dry on Sunday morning and we could continue with the competition.

The finals were awesome! I pushed hard and stayed clean when it was required - according to Stefan Pfeifhofer RC.

2WD A-main: I could finish as **3rd**. 2nd became Philipp Märzinger 2nd (great job Märzi) and Hupo Hönigl became 1st.

4WD A-main: Sadly I only finished **10th**. It was really difficult to compete against the Xray XB4 and Team Associated B64 cars, but we are still working to make our car better and better!

In both classes I was awarded **best youngster**.
